

## Safeguarding children and young people

Chabad Youth is committed to safeguarding children and young people in its care. As part of this commitment, we have developed practice and behaviour guidelines for our organisation, and these are approved and endorsed by Rabbi Moshe Kahn

All our 'involved' personnel, from Rabbi Moshe Kahn and senior managers to casual employees and volunteers, are required to observe our practice and behaviour guidelines.

Management considers a failure to observe our guidelines to be misconduct, and will result in appropriate disciplinary action. Depending on the seriousness of the misconduct, disciplinary action may include suspension while matters are investigated and/or dismissal. In addition to any internal disciplinary proceedings, any breaches of law will be reported to police.
