## Outside School Hours Care

Outside school hours care centers provide care for primary school aged children, before and after school, during school holidays and on pupil-free days.

Vacation care is a type of outside school hour's care that includes indoor and outdoor activities. These centers are sometimes run by the same organisation that runs before and after-school care.

The majority of outside school hours care centers are approved child care services. This means that families using the service may be eligible for the Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate. Approved services must also show that they are meeting certain quality standards.

# Child Care Subsidy

The package includes a new Child Care Subsidy, which replaces the current Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate. The Child Care Subsidy will be paid directly to services.

There are also changes to the annual cap which will make child care more affordable for most families.

### Three things will determine a family's level of Child Care Subsidy:

- » Combined family income
- » Activity level of parents
- » Type of child care service

Some basic requirements must be satisfied for an individual to be eligible to receive Child Care Subsidy for a child.

### These include:

- » The age of the child (must be 13 or under and not attending secondary school)
- » The child meeting immunisation requirements
- » The individual, or their partner, meeting the residency requirements.
